

# PROSPECTUS FOR FIVE YEARS INTEGRATED B.A. LL.B. (Hons) Course (CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM)

## INTRODUCTION

The Fakir Mohan University, Vyasa Vihar, Balasore was established by the Government of Odisha, under Section 32 of the Odisha Universities Act, 1989 (Act 5 of 1989) and it was notified vide the Government's Notification No. 973 dated 3rd July, 1999. The University has also been duly recognized by the UGC under section 2(f) of the UGC Act by the Notification No. F-9-1 / 2000 (CPP-I), dated 11<sup>th</sup> February 2000 as well as under section 12(B), vide UGC letter No. F.9-1 / 2000 (CPP-I) dated 23rd December, 2005. It has also been accredited by the Association of Indian Universities, vide their letter No. Meet: SC: 261:2K/108693, dated 22nd August, 2000. At present it is functioning in two campuses: the old campus at Januganj, besides the N.H. near Remuna Golai and the new campus at Nuapadhi, in and around Balasore town. The University has got (B+) NAAC Accreditation in the year 2016-17.

The Fakir Mohan University is committed to develop itself as a value and need based quality education provider in the state of Odisha in general and Balasore and Bhadrak district in particular. It has the ultimate objective of producing qualified and competent manpower responsive to the changing needs of the society at the national and international level. To fulfill the long standing demands of the people of North Odisha Fakir Mohan University introduce the Five Year Integrated LLB Course from the session 2017-18 under Self Financing mode at Balasore Law College, Balasore. The curriculum is designed by F.M. University as per the guidelines prescribed by the Bar Council of India and U.G.C.

**THE NAME OF THE DEPARTMENT:** The name of the department is "Department of Law, Balasore Law College, F.M. University.

**PROGRAMME OFFERED:** F.M. University has decided to impart Five Year Integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) course at Balasore Law College, O.T. Road, Balasore from the academic Session 2017-18 under Self Financing Mode. The course is at par with the syllabus prescribed by the leading Universities/Law Schools in India offering Five Year Integrated B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Programme in law.

**STUDENT STRENGTH :** The student strength is 60 seats per year.

**RESERVATION :** Subject to eligibility and proof of belonging to the quota category, reservation of seats will be as follows:

- i. SC - 8% and ST - 12% of the sanctioned strength of the College. These seats are not interchangeable among themselves.
- ii. 1% of the seats for self/daughter/wife of Ex-servicemen.
- iii. 3% of seats for Physically Handicapped students with more than 40% disability. (Certificate from CDMO or equivalent officer is to be furnished.)
- iv. In any of the above reserved category, the balance lying, if any (after admitting the students of that category) shall be filled up by the general candidate as per the merit list.

**WEIGHTAGE:** Weightage and special consideration will be given in the following cases:

**Sports:** The following categories of sports persons will be given admission/weightage under the sport category subject to selection of a maximum of 2% of total number of seats.

- i. Representing the country at International level- Direct Admission.
- ii. Representing the State at National Level - 10% additional mark over the aggregate.

- iii. Representing the University at Inter University level - 5% additional mark over the aggregate.
- iv. The above mentioned sports must be recognized or organized by the Director of Sports or University Sports Council. In order to get the weightage in sports the concerned applicant must have participated in the respective competitions within three years before the date of application for admission.

**N.B.:** The above rules regarding reservations and weightage are however subject to rules framed by the Govt. of Odisha in this regard from time to time. The merit list in ultimate drawn by the Institution shall be final for all purposes.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION INTO 5 YEARS LAW COURSE:** A candidate shall be eligible for admission into 5-year B.A.LL.B. (Hons.), If he/she has passed +2 Examination (at least 10+2 pattern) securing a minimum of 45% marks of the total marks in such exam. However in case of SC/ST students, this is relaxable to 40% provide that such minimum qualifying mark shall not automatically entitle a candidate to get admission. He has to fulfill other institutional criteria, if any, fixed by the concerned college.

**APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION:** Application form along with prospectus can be obtained from the office of Balasore Law College on payment of Rs.500/- in person. Application cum Prospectus may also be downloaded from the college website ([www.balasurelawcollege.org](http://www.balasurelawcollege.org)). The duly filled in application form along with required documents is required to be deposited at the college office in person or can be sent in the college address (Principal, Balasore Law College, O.T. Road, Balasore - 756001, Odisha). However the college shall not be held liable for any postal delay.

**The following self attested documents are to be attached along with the Application Form:**

1. 10th Certificate and Mark sheet.
2. 12th (+2) certificate & Mark sheet.
3. College Leaving Certificate from the Institution last attended.
4. Caste Certificate in case of SC/ST /OBC/ SEBC category.
5. Four Passport size photographs signed by candidates.
6. One self addressed stamped (of Rs. 25/-) envelopes (9" X 5")
7. Original Money receipt of the Application form.
8. Downloaded application form in case of online applicants.

**LAST DATE OF SALE AND SUBMISSION OF FORM:** Sale and submission of application form for admission into 5year B.A.LL.B (Hons) Course. Course is within 15 days from the date of publication of +2 Examination results of C.H.S.E. Odisha or within 15days from reopening of the college after summer vacation, which is later.

**PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION INTO 5 YEARS B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) COURSE:** Intimation for admission would be sent to the selected applicants by Email or Speed Post and the selection list will be notified on the Notice Board of the College. Selected candidates are required to produce the following original documents at the time of admission

- a. Intimation letter signed by the principal or Downloaded Intimation letter.
- b. Original School Leaving/ College Leaving Certificate of the School/ College last attended.
- c. Original MIGRATION CERTIFICATE.

- d. Original 10th and 12th Mark sheets and Certificates. (for verification only)
- e. Four copies of passport size photographs and one stamp size photo for I. Card.
- f. In case of duplicate CLC an affidavit showing that the original CLC is not used in any other educational Institution.
- g. Caste or other backward class Certificate (In case of SC/ST/OBC/SECBC candidates) issued by competent authority.
- h. Handicapped certificate (In case of PH candidates) issued by CDMO.

**SELECTION OF CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION:** Selection will be made strictly on mark basis taking into consideration the aggregate marks of the qualifying examination. All admissions are provisional and the admission cannot be claimed as matter of right. Merit and good conduct of the applicant are the basis of selection for admission into this college. Suppression of facts or giving incorrect information by the applicant if detected at any time shall render the selection / admission invalid. The decision of the principal in matters of selection for admission shall be binding and final.

**COURSE FEE:** The course fee is Rs- 35,000/- per year and a candidate is required to pay the amount of Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees thirty five thousand only), in shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Principal, Balasore Law College, Payable at Balasore from any Nationalized Bank.

**COLLEGE LIBRARY:** Balasore Law College has got an independent and well equipped library with sufficient number of Reference, Text books and Dictionaries to cater to the needs of the students. Besides the College also subscribes several reputed Law Journals, Periodicals, Reports, Digests, etc. Reading Room facility is available to the students. The library is going to be computerized very soon.

**FACULTIES:** Balasore Law College has highly qualified and well experienced faculties to teach students.

**EXAMINATION:** At the end of each semester the University will conduct the examination. Normally the Odd Semester exams. takes place in the month of December and Even Semester exams. takes place in the month of June/ July of every year. However the 10<sup>th</sup> sem. exams. are conducted during the month of April or May. The candidates have to attend classes in each semester as per university rules. For the purpose of appearing the University examination the candidates are required to deposit the examination fees as prescribed by the University from time to time. Ordinarily the form fill up of Odd Semesters takes place during the month of November and Even semesters in the month of March. The students are required to follow the notice time to time for information and confirmation.

**READMISSION:** An eligible student is required to take readmission on deposit of fees in each next year. A student admitted into 5years LL.B. course is required to take readmission into 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th year course only when he/she became eligible. Normally readmission takes place in the month of July. Students must follow the notice board of the college relating to dates and fees of readmission or else his/her studentship may be ceased.

**AWARD OF DEGREE:** On successful completion of the Course and examinations (all the 10 semesters) the candidate will be awarded B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) degree by the F.M. University i.e. within 7 years from the year of admission.

**CAMPUS DISCIPLINE:** A student of this college must behave and conduct himself / herself in a disciplined manner both inside and outside the College premises. He/she must

abide by all the rules and regulations prescribeds from time to time by the College Authorities and shall not conduct himself/herself in any manner prejudicial to the honour and dignity of the Institution.

The campus of the College is strictly a no-smoking and non-alcoholic Zone. Any deviation from this will be seriously viewed which shall attract strong action from the authorities. Ragging and Sexual Harassment are also strictly prohibited. Strong disciplinary proceeding shall be initiated against the student violating these, which may result in severe punishment including suspension and expulsion from the Institution. The decision of the principal with regard to the matters not covered in this prospectus or with regard to any dispute arising out of the interpretation of any clause/clauses of the prospectus, shall be final and binding.

**COLLEGE UNIFORM:** In compliance to the Bar Council of India's has a guide line relating to Dress Code. Students of a college shall have formal Dress as follows:

For all – White/Black Trouser. Full sleeve, white Shirt, (Black Tie and Black Coat optional)

Optional For Girls- Black boarded white Saree with white full sleeve blouse or White Salwar, white apron (Black coat optional). The students are bound to wear the Uniform from the day and date to be notified by the College.

**COURSE STRUCTURE:** Course has 10 (ten) semesters. In 10 semesters, there shall be 60 papers with 6 papers in each semester carrying 100 marks. The Course structure of the programme will have 360 credits in ten semesters.
